⁵Tax incentives for Ford, Mercury, Toyota (except the Camry) and Lexus are the official figures from the IRS. Others are estimates from the American Council for an Energy Efficient Economy.

⁶Future models are based on the best available information; there is no guarantee these vehicles will be available in the model year given.

⁷Ford has tentatively said more hybrids are coming, i.e. Ford Five Hundred/Mercury Montego and the new Ford Edge/Mercury MKX (compact SUVs), but no dates have been announced.

⁸These trucks are minimal hybrids. The mpg gain is ~1mpg and they are only in limited production.
